Explore the website, seek information about the EUKCEM project which allowed the creation of this website, look for information about the ERASMUS+ programme, search for sending organisations and host entities in a destination country and search for the routes of success. **There are 3 routes for success**, one for each of the key stakeholders involved in the process of European mobility – sending organisations, host organisations and beneficiaries.

Each route is represented by a metro line with metro stops. Each stop, which includes a number of action points, is an important step in the mobility process.

4. Register your organisation and enter the Community of Quality Organisations in European mobility.

5. Choose the line that represents better your organisation and follow the metro line through each stop. Read the information carefully at each of these stops (important phases of the mobility process), pay attention to the sub-stops, analyse the given information and additional sources of information, as advised.
