The TRACK focus groups: Valuing the outcomes for the labour market

From November 2013 till January 2014, focus groups are organized with labour market representatives in the trade, hospitality and construction sector. The main purpose was to inform the stakeholders about the TRACK outcomes and to get feedback on the tools and developments from a labour market

point of view.

The Main topics for discussion were the working processes within the specific sector, the descriptors (to be used for training and assessment) and the opportunities of the Europass mobility for the companies.

Generally speaking the stakeholders were positive about the tools and support of the TRACK project. The flowcharts with the working processes per sector seem to be very valuable for having an overview of training and career opportunities and the descriptors and observation checklist are recognized as valuable “hand-on” tool for the companies to evaluate trainees during their internship.

The TRACK competence database: Tbase A tool to improve mutual trust in mobility

The Tbase allows the users to produce a training program for students and trainers and to produce professional behaviour observation sheets for the hosting company to support the assessment process. The application integrates the de-

finied learning outcomes directly in the Europass Mobility Supplement. All the documents are produced in Word format, thus allowing the users to edit, adapt and modify the content to different validation and certification habits in

use in the various countries/regions.
