TraWi – A transnational project for the cooperation in vocational education and training

*Why has Germany such a low youth unemployment, compared to other European Countries?
What can be learned abroad and how can you shape vocational education and training (VET)
in a more work-based way in Poland and the Czech Republic?*

16 partners from Germany, Poland and the Czech Republic cooperate in the project “Transfer of experiences for the creation of an economy-oriented, work-based VET in the structures of school-oriented educational and training systems”, in order to get to know better the reciprocal VET systems.

Due to his success in the reduction of youth unemployment, the dual training system in Germany is considered in Europe as an example of good practice. Through this cooperation, the institutions involved in the project (VET providers, school administrators, companies and social partners) want to shape the school-oriented education systems in Poland and the Czech Republic in the chemical sector in a more world of work-oriented way.

Specific working groups will be set up to analyze didactical-methodological approaches and exemplary work tasks in schools and companies for laboratory technicians and chemical plant operators in the field of chemistry. A survey amongst companies will be carried out to analyze which profile requirements the employers expect from employees concerning some selected professions in the chemical sector. Based on these analyzes, new vocational education concepts will be developed to be tested and evaluated during the school year 2014-2015 in the school-based institutions and in the companies.

TraWi is a Leonardo da Vinci – Transfer of Innovation project within the framework of the Lifelong Learning Programme of the European Union and is funded with support of the European Commission. It began on 01/10/2013 and will end on 30/09/2015.
