


3rd Evaluation for the Preparation of our Meeting in Zurich (22. – 24. October 2014)

1. Could you realize all steps of your working plan since the last meeting?



Comments:

- We've tried to do new trainings but it was very difficult to plan days with the associations of migrants women.
- We haven't prepared the exercises for the online tool.
- We have tried trainings with migrant women seven times with different results, and we are still trying to find a partner organization for the learning difficulties group.
- Yes I have realized things though I really see that many things, which we had planned before, haven't been done so far (regarding our organization). Partly because of the summer we could not make an advance - or not as much as we wanted :-)

2. Are there any aspects which are not clear enough to work with?

- We have to define what kind of video material we want to produce. It has to be done before or at the meeting in Zurich.
- Everything is clear about the project but we have problems finding organizations that are ready to take part in it.
- No unclear aspects (2 persons)

3. Is there any aspect where you would need more support?

- I need more connections to the groups of people who are working with the same target groups. (Normally it's in my hand to ask it)
- We get good support from the coordinators but I have some questions about the financial part (we could discuss it in Zurich)

4. In your opinion, what are the most important tasks for our 4th meeting in Zurich? (Agenda, time schedule, exchange of experience, specific inputs...)


- Know where we are and what the next specific steps are. Work, work and work in groups.

- I think we should talk about the format / standard of the training exercises and the descriptions / summaries - the way we will script our trainings and exercises to a standard form.


6. How satisfied are you with the organisation of our project, so far?

- Better exchange of information between partner meetings is needed.


7. Could you work well with the agreements on tasks and next steps we agreed on in Graz?
