4th INTERNATIONAL MEETING IN ESTONIA

The 4th International Meeting took place in the offices of the School for Disabled Children in Urveste, which has cooperated with Siksali on the project. This placement allowed us to observe on site the framework where the piloting of the training materials that we are preparing with our European partners has been developed.

The aims of the meeting were:

1^o Exchanging training and piloting experiences in each country.

2^o Sharing and making decisions on the implementation of the final product: The training cards.

3^o Coming to a decision on how to include assessment in the training cards.

4^o Undertaking commitments on the impact and dissemination of the final product.

During the two days each of the partners exposed the work developed on the piloting of training materials.

The positive and improvement points of each experience were emphasised and this led to reconsider the contents and methodologies of the

training cards. Agreements on the elaboration of the final product: "Guide of good practices at European level" were reached. This guide would be composed of an introduction, the training cards and a set of recommendations written by all partners.

The foundations for the holding of a seminar of dissemination organised by each partner in their country, before 30th September were laid. Every partner will prepare their own programme for the seminar and should provide attendance lists, pictures and any other document of interest.

We also agreed on the definitive dates for holding the International Seminar in Altea which will take place from 8th to 11th September 2015 with the following schedule:

8th and 11th September will be days of journey, 9th a day of work in Altea and finally on 10th September will be held the final seminar in the University of Alicante with expositions by each partner country.

In conclusion, the goal of this international meeting was to share the

results of the experience of the training modules in each country.

Our commitment from the beginning of the Project has been to elaborate training cards which include practical exercises which help us to improve the competences of professionals working with children and to corroborate the pedagogical and methodological results of these cards with the professionals who work on the ground.

Each country has piloted those didactic units which were more interesting for their work environment. After experience and analysis in every country, the more successful aspects of the developed materials so far were detected as well as other aspects that should be reconsidered and improved.
