SEATRaining

Comprehensive training in European leisure harbours



The European leisure harbours are facing new challenges in the staff training field due to globalization and the increasing importance of the harbour environment. To solve this, the *Instituto de Estudios Potuarios de la Comunitat Valenciana* (FEPORTS), (in English means the Harbour Studies Institute of the Valencian Region), leads the **SEATRaining Project**, an initiative in the training field addressed to nautical facilities employees. The aim of the project included in the Leonardo Da Vinci's Programme consists of providing them with a specific training model for their professional abilities.

Thus, SEATRaining is born as an answer to the new training needs appeared in the last years due to the nautical tourism growth. These lacks has been more visible, especially in the following fields: adaptation of the offered services to users, environmental management, nautical sport facilities protection and security, information technology development, historical-artistic heritage maintenance related to these facilities and nautical fleet and infrastructures modernization.

From the cooperation between associations, training and research centres, and nautical sector professional staff, SEATRaining will create a training, security and protection, environmental and harbour management experience exchange forum, so the nautical facilitation professional staff abilities be facilitated by means of a specific and adapted training program to the work requirements in this field.

SEATRaining sets up a starting point for the nautical sector increase, as it groups training organizations, national and European company associations, as well as businesspeople, so that the main European involved agents can take part of the project

In this process, the first step consists of creating a common catalogue of professional profiles, in such a way that could be carried out a homogenization of the recruitment processes, facilitating in that way the access to employment in the European market. The next step is the detection of the specific training needs in the areas where the project is going to be put into practice, followed by the creation of a curriculum system and the development of pilot experiences. Finally, the project is going to be managed, disseminated and exploited.

The SEATRaining project led by FEPORTS, counts on different partners such as Federación Española de Asociaciones de Puertos Deportivos y Turísticos (Spain), Euomarinas (France), Assonautica (Italy) and INNOREG (Hungary). Moreover, the Fundación Comunidad Valenciana-Región Europea (Spain) is subcontracted as a partner in the dissemination of the project.
