

Creative Futures is developing a web based e-learning environment that explores new concepts such as virtual worlds, social nets and open source applications. The e-learning package includes a training course for e-tutors in order to guide the learner through a multifaceted environment and engage him in an interactive process.

Above everything, Creative Futures embraces a new spirit, which is at the heart of the project: playing as a way of learning.



Beyond the vocational content offered, the project will emphasize the e-learning practice as a further personal accomplishment in gaining computer literacy.



Creative Futures aims to set an environment where information, knowledge and experience will be smoothly transferred. And the key aspect will be "people", and their capacity to manage different elements of the Internet world, directing them towards a common goal.



The basis of Creative Futures is a collaborative environment that will be fed by our curiosity and capacity to partake in the most challenging aspect of our time: the process of life long learning where the student and the tutor are equal partners and active participants in the creation of the curriculum.



The curriculum TPBLEap - Creative Futures is currently under development as a "Transfer of Innovation" project of the Life Long Learning Initiative of the EU. It includes courses in Theatre Lighting, Sound, Costume Design and Stage Management. Users in formal training settings as well as individual learners in informal settings will be able to participate in this open learning system.



TPBLEap - Creative Futures will be released in September 2010.



The final structure of the e-learning package is aimed to be flexible enough to adopt new content, to consider new technologies and address a wide range of target groups.
