 Marketing Text: The demand for ecologically sound materials has been rising constantly in the past years, and the awareness increasingly concerns not only food and health sector, but also the building sector. Ecologic and sustainable building and insulation materials show significantly higher growth rates than conventional materials. Using clay (hlína) as building material, especially for wall plastering, has become an attractive alternative for builders and building companies. However, the non-standardised characteristics of these materials require special knowledge and experienced handicraft skills.

The LEONARDO DA VINCI project "Clay Plaster" was an efficient answer to meet this demand. It developed an accompanying vocational qualification measure for clay plaster and building design with clay. The Curriculum has a modular structure and enables thus to take into account the various skills levels of the learners and the various requirements of their clients.

The project has won the "Best Practice Award" of the German National Agency.

We have selected this project to be transferred to other countries because it meets the requirements in the countries of the target partners, especially because it delivers much needed sensitisation in combination with delivering the respective background knowledge.

We will adapt these learning materials by a linguistic, cultural and sociological customisation for the specific requirements in each of the three target countries (Czech Republic, Slovakia, Slovenia). All materials will be produced for download at the project's website as well as hardcopies (paper form, CD-ROM and DVD).

As added value the project team will provide VETrainers and teachers with Didactic Guidelines on how to incorporate these materials within the framework of existing teaching schemes and take into consideration the specific requirements of each country as well as the specific learning cultures, the requirements of vocational training providers, and aspects of transparency, validation and recognition of the competences acquired in such training measures.

Zusammenfassung: Hlinarch toolbox is the first material covering the complex issue of clay building design in the Czech Republic, Slovakia and Slovenia. The toolbox "Clay plaster" is a CD that is designed for lecturers and people interested in practical skills within clay plaster work. The course contains theory, practical solutions and marketing basics.

Beschreibung: Within the Hlinarch project a complex curriculum for the retraining course "Clay plaster design" has been created based on a previous LdV project "Lehmputze und Gestaltung". The original curriculum has been translated and adapted into Czech, Slovakian and Slovenian. The products of the project comprise of a printed curriculum of approx. 550 pages containing three volumes (production, design and marketing of clay plaster) and a CD with a navigated electronic version of the curriculum. A short promotion version of the curriculum dedicated to promotion of the course has been created to be downloaded from the website. In addition to those translated and adapted materials further products have been created for each of the importing countries separately. The didactic concept consists of useful information about the use of the curriculum within the educational framework in each importing country. The implementation concept describes the state of arts concerning clay plaster education in each importing country, the process of implementation of the curriculum within the project period and future activities immediately resulting from

the Hlinarch project. Besides these products there is also a project website and flyers in all importer partners' languages. As additional product, there is also a promotion movie about the Hlinarch project.

All these materials are valuable instructions for trainers and teachers that enable them to teach professional courses based on this curriculum. Already during the validation workshops, selected trainers have been trained in using the curriculum. As a result of the Hlinarch project commercial courses have been offered or will be offered soon in Czech Republic, Slovakia and Slovenia using the whole curriculum or its part. Various steps have been undertaken in order to incorporate the retraining materials in the existing VET framework such as accreditation applications or an establishment of new sub-occupation within current catalogues of job positions. The implementation of the project products has been done in accordance with the state of arts in each of the importing countries. The processes and results reached have been described in the national Implementation concepts.

During the project period both experts and wide public were informed about the project and its outputs. Project partners succeeded to address diverse audience presenting the project and its outputs at international conferences, national meetings, seminars, workshops and also in many one to one meetings with important stakeholders in their countries. According to expert opinion the Hlinarch project brought systematization into the field of clay plaster education in the three importing countries and represents a good practice example how professional curricula for other subjects within the sustainable building sector should be created.
