"HeLPS Transfer - Helps for High Training and High School" is a project aimed at the transfer of innovation derived from the need of some universities and other Italian and European organizations engaged in the field of Education and Vocational Training to use the results of the project entitled "HeLPS - High e-Learning Professional Skills". HeLPS Transfer then originates from the possibility to transform an e-Learning excellence initiative into the drive of an actual transformation and enhancement of knowledge, models, methodologies, school-university didactic-educational systems and professionalization of the e-Learning sector, in Italy and Europe. The general aim of the Project is "To transfer the results of the HeLPS Project in the framework of High School, University and Post-University High Training through the specialization of the training pathways developed by the project on the basis of the needs of the two reference sectors, the linguistic localization and structural adaptation of the main products and tools realized by HeLPS and the training and orientation of school and university operators".

The mains products of the HELPS Project we have:

- Post-University Masters for training HeLPS professional figures.
- Consolidated and localized e-DD&P methodology.
- Book "From Didactics to e-Didactics - Paradigms, Models and Techniques for e-Learning" published in all the partnership languages both in hardcopy version and e-Book version
- eDD&P Methodology and e-Stage System application tools, included the e-Stage Web, localized in the languages of the Consortium.
- Seminars for Trainers and School and University Teachers.
- HeLPS Transfer Portal

"T&T - Telework and Training - Work at Distance to Teach at Distance" is a project aimed at the transfer of innovation of results of pilot project TES (Telework Education System) in several European countries. The project TES has received numerous national and international recognitions. TES results raised a specific interest as training, information and telework orientation tools.

The main goal of the **Telework and Training** project is to transfer the results of TES project to telework training of education and training operators through the translation and adaptation of the training modules to the e-training context, the linguistic localization and the structural adaptation of the main TES products.

The specific objectives of the T&T project are:

- analyze and adapt TES model and system and TES training modules. Implement the linguistic localizations of the T&T portal and updated training modules.
- plan and implement three training courses and three updating seminars
- realize and publish a book in hardcopy and e-book format, in Romanian and in all the other partnership languages that are different from Italian and English.

The T&T project has the following planned education and academic outcomes:

- a series of training modules;
- e-learning courses associated to training modules;
- orientation seminars for potential learners;
- didactic textbook;
- "Telework & Training" portal.

The Conference

The conference is organised by the Centre for Advanced Technologies of the University Politehnica of Bucharest within the scope of two Projects, of two Transnational Partnerships (of which CTANM is Partner or Promoter), financed by the Community Action Programme **Life Long Learning**, Sectorial Programme **Leonardo da Vinci**, **Transfer of Innovation**. Both the Projects, named respectively **"HeLPS Transfer - Helps for High Education and High School"** and **"T&T - Telework and Training - To work at distance to teach ad distance"** operates in the area of e-Learning and both, in particular, work on specifics topics related with the professional, organisational and methodological aspects of the Distance Learning.

The conference's goal is to directly and publicly disseminate the projects' initiatives and planned results. Also, the conference aims in attracting stakeholders that are interested in joining projects as silent partners. These stakeholders can be individuals or organisations interested in applying the projects' methodology and results.

"Life Long Learning" Programme - Sub-Programme "Leonardo da Vinci"

The European Commission has integrated its various educational and training initiatives under a single umbrella, the Lifelong Learning Programme. With a significant budget of nearly €7 billion for 2007 to 2013, the new programme replaces previous education, vocational training and e-Learning programmes, which ended in 2006.

*The programme enables individuals at all stages of their lives to pursue stimulating learning opportunities across Europe. There are four sub-programmes focusing on different stages of education and training and continuing previous programmes: **Comenius** for schools, **Erasmus** for higher education, **Leonardo da Vinci** for vocational education and training, **Grundtvig** for adult education*

A transversal programme aims to ensure that they achieve the best results possible. Four key activities focus on policy co-operation, languages, information and communication technologies, effective dissemination and exploitation of project results. Aiming for a geographical reach beyond Europe's borders, the Jean Monnet programme stimulates teaching, reflection and debate on the European integration process at higher education institutions worldwide.

*The **Leonardo da Vinci programme** links policy to practice in the field of vocational education and training (VET). Projects range from those giving individuals the chance to improve their competences, knowledge and skills through a period abroad, to Europe-wide co-operation between training organisations. Part of the European Commission's Lifelong Learning Programme, the programme funds a wide range of actions, notably cross-border mobility initiatives; co-operation projects to develop and spread innovation; and thematic networks. The potential beneficiaries are similarly wide – from trainees in initial vocational training, to people already in the labour market, as well as VET professionals and private or public organisations active in this field.*

Leonardo da Vinci enables VET organisations to work with European partners, exchange best practices, increasing the expertise of their staff and respond to the teaching and learning needs of people. It therefore supports efforts to make vocational education more attractive to young people. By helping European citizens to acquire new skills, knowledge and qualifications, the programme also aims to bolster the competitiveness of the European labour market. Innovation projects have always been at the core of the Leonardo da Vinci programme. They aim to improve the quality of training systems through the development and transfer of innovative policies, contents, methods and procedures within vocational education and training.

*The **Leonardo da Vinci actions** are:*

- *Mobility (Certificate, Preparatory visits, Initial vocational training, People in the labour market, Professionals in vocational education and training)*
- *Partnerships*
- *Multilateral projects (Transfer of innovation, Development of innovation, Thematic networks)*
