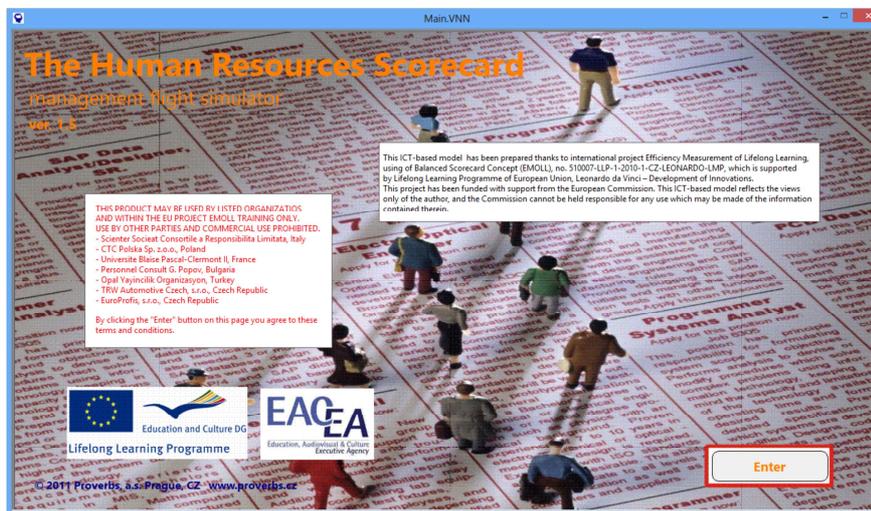

System requirements to install and run the software:

- OS Windows XP and higher
- 200 MB free HDD space
- minimal screen resolution 1280x760pixels

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

There are two folders on the installation CD. One is named „Sable Runtime“ and the other „HR Scorecard“.

- 1.** First of all, HDD installation of Sable runtime is needed. Installation requires administrator rights. There's the only file in "Sable Runtime" folder named "Sable Runtime Setup.exe".
  - a. Click on the program icon and run the installation.
  - b. Install the software into default location (recommended).
  - c. Exit the installation program after the installation.
- 2.** The only file in "HR Scorecard" named "HR Scorecard.spk" is a packaged file containing all the data required to run the simulation.
  - a. Move the file into any location on your hard drive, but writing-changing the file and creating temporary folders must be allowed there (preferably create a folder in your Documents)
- 3.** Try to click on the file, the simulator should pop up.
- 4.** Some Windows versions don't create a link between Sable runtime file type and the executable file.
- 5.** If the OS displays an error message saying something like "do not know the file type" or "unknown software needed to open", select "choose program" from installed programs (or similar selection depending on your operating system version).
- 6.** Windows usually opens "Program Files" folder. If you happen to have 64 bit version of the operating system, you have to switch manually into "Program Files x86". Then look for subfolder named "Ventana Systems UK", then "Sable", and so on until you find file named "SableRTU.exe" that you select, click OK and the link will therefore be created
