
Welcome!




The MOVE-ON application

The MOVE-ON application is being developed for iPhone devices. The courses focus on the topics: Project Management, Financial Management and Negotiations.

Each MOVE-ON course consists of a series of 20 ten-minute episodes and are highly interactive as a result of a combination of informative and experimental elements (text, videos, photos, animations, exercises, games, etc.).

The ultimate product of the MOVE-ON project will be a multilingual (BG, IT, HU, EN, EL) mobile learning platform with courses available on all five languages.

Technical background


The MOVE-ON system comprises of two main subsystems, the Distance Learning Platform (DLP) and the smartphone (iPhone) application. Learners have access to the system only via the smartphone interface. Tutors and content providers (e.g. educational institutions) have

access to the system via the DLP. The two subsystems communicate over the Internet.

The smartphone application comprises of a native shell application that handles the content delivery and the local data storage. It is also connected to the DLP for dynamic content

delivery and for uploading the final exam results for each course. For that purpose, the DLP publishes certain services over an application programming interface (API). All course content is in HTML5 format.
