e2-p at a glance...

Entrepreneurship is a chance for young people, particularly graduates of vocational based education, to set up their own business. But how can you support these people in transforming their ideas into successful businesses? This question is being answered by an international consortium under the leadership of HAFELEKAR Consultancy in Innsbruck.

E2-p is funded by the Leonardo da Vinci programme of the European Commission, and aims to develop two tools that support entrepreneurs during the foundation process; an information portal that provides comprehensive information about business formation and a portfolio instrument, which helps to identify skills and competencies. The e2-p info-portal in combination with the e2-p portfolio tool can be seen as a gateway for "young" entrepreneurs to identify, improve and promote their individual skills.

Our info-portal enables users to deal with a wide range of detailed information and knowledge for business formation: relevant information can be selected and linked interactively. The portal is easy to use, and an excellent environment for the presentation of the e-portfolio.

This is an instrument to help identify, document and record individual skills and competences. It aims to initiate processes of reflection on skills gained in a wide range of contexts and to support the creation of users own educational biographies. The e2-p portfolio can be seen as a digital collection of work done and a description of individual skill, which documents an entrepreneur's development. In a second step the portfolio can be used as a marketing tool in order to promote a person, an idea or specific products.

For example, one of Austria's associated partners ÖSB Consulting consults 12% of all business founders in Austria each year. In total 17 partners from six European countries - Austria, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Poland and Spain - are involved in the development, piloting, dissemination and exploitation of the e2-p results.
