The Aim of ELEVET

The aim of the project is to facilitate mobility of electricians and electrical engineers in Europe by improving transparency and establishing recognition of learning outcomes – both acquired in formal and non-formal training paths. Further, to modernise VET paths of electricians and electrical engineers through an integration of a set of soft- and business skills.

Meeting of the Monitoring Committee and the Steering Committee in Odense/Denmark

On 14 - 15 March 2013 at the premises of SDE College in Odense (Denmark) the next meetings of the Monitoring Committee and the Steering Committee of the EU project ELEVET were held. The previous three meetings were held in Warsaw (November 2011), Rome (May 2012) and Madrid (September 2012). The meeting was chaired by Professor Jerzy Barglik – the President of SEP.
