The Barefoot Trainer will be tailored to meet the differing requirements of trainers in different organisations. It will be an enjoyable, hands on, interactive course peppered with exercises and activities that will allow participants to learn easily and achieve their goals. It will also provide you, the trainer with useful, effective and highly desirable recognised qualification.
