The project also realizes a pilot course that applies the model of intervention above and uses the most advanced training methods and technologies.

PROJECT WWW

World Wide Women is a project within the Leonardo da Vinci program, realized for the first participation of Switzerland to the European programme of permanent professional training (*Lifelong Learning Programme*).

WWW aims at evaluating and transferring in the German-speaking Switzerland and in the other countries of the partnership (Italy, Romania and Spain) the successful educational method of the *EFIS: Service de formation pour Italiennes en Suisse* project, tested in the French-speaking Switzerland.

World Wide Women knows that it is necessary to develop new training models that allow the educated immigrant women in the European countries not to be excluded from the local labour market. Although they often possess a high social, cultural and professional potential, they are able to integrate and be successful only with great effort.

The largest part of the immigration-supporting programmes is conceived for a poorly qualified audience. Educated foreign women have then to create themselves their paths of integration and professional (re)al location. Il transfer viene garantito sia a livello nazionale che europeo attraverso:

PROJECT EFIS



EFIS was an excellence project achieved in 2009-2011 by a partnership consisting of five Italian organizations and the Swiss Foundation ECAP - coordinated by PIEMMEI Naples for Training - and funded by the Ministry of Labour and Social Policy within the scope of training initiatives targeted to Italian population living abroad. The project

aimed to provide a target of Italian women of the territories of Lausanne and Geneva:

- a permanent training, information and advice service to enable them to gain a greater understanding and awareness of their own skills and knowledge and enhance their marketability in the local labor market;
- a specialized training service for women with a degree of low-skilled, to acquire the expertise and technology competencies need in order to enter, as appropriate, in the labor market;
- a specialized training service for women who possess a weak diploma or professional qualification, to acquire the skills and develop their own talents and skills to enhance the opportunity of making a personal project of self-employment.

The project was attended by over one hundred women divided into five specific courses and has developed a strong and significant intervention model for this type of women excluded or at risk of exclusion from the labor market.

The Ministry of Labour and Social Policy promotes initiatives aimed at training the Italians resident in countries outside the European Union, pursuant to Legislative Decree 112/98 art.142/lett. h). For the implementation of the interventions there is the

collaboration of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, through the Consulates and Embassies of the territory. The interventions aim, on the one hand, to strengthen the role of local authorities in view of supplementary training activities and local development in the area and, secondly, to develop and upgrade the skills of individuals.
