## Information sur le projet

Titre: Les 8 solutions pour lutter contre le décrochage scolaire dans l'EFPP

Accroche marketing: Le projet met l'accent sur l'importance de la formation continue pour les enseignants de FEP qui doivent faire face à la nécessité de réduire le nombre de jeunes en décrochage scolaire au cours des prochaines années. La réduction de l'abandon scolaire précoce adresses à la fois les objectifs de «croissance intelligente» en améliorant les niveaux d'éducation et de formation et les objectifs de «croissance inclusive» en s'attaquant à l'un des principaux facteurs de risque d'exclusion du chômage, de la pauvreté et sociales.

Résumé: The project "The 8 solution for fighting early school leaving in VET" could give a strong and visible signal to the European VET schools and also to find out some possible solutions for reducing the number of the early school leaving in VET.  
The main aim of the project is to identify the main factors of the early school leaving in VET, in order to reduce drop-outs by increasing motivation of the VET students and helping them to adapt to the Lifelong Learning Society. The project will focus on the teachers working with VET students, including groups at increased risk of early school leaving (e.g: children with a socio-economical disadvantaged background, with migrant background or with special educational needs); this because being a teacher of the mentioned group of students requires many soft skills in order to support, understand and motivate the students to continue their compulsory education and to be able to obtain a diploma/qualification/certification. It is necessary to build also the awareness of the school managers and the decision makers in the field of VET regarding the existing problem of early school leaving.  
The consortium includes 6 partners from 4 countries from: three from EU (NL, IT, UK), as well as an acceding country (TR). The structure of the consortium has a multi player dimension (adult education provider, voluntary organization, VET school, center for drop-outs, regional authorities).  
Outcomes: Tangible (Project web site; Coaching guide for teachers working in VET schools; Quality procedures for reducing drop-outs in VET schools; Collection of innovative teaching and training approaches and methods for reducing early school leaving in VET; Guidelines app for teachers working with VET students in risk of drop-out; Kit for VET schools for identifying the students in risk of drop-out; Training package for peer training for VET teachers) & Intangible (School committee quality assurance teams).  
Impact: short term (decreasing the number of drop-outs, through motivating VET students and training their teachers) & long term (introducing Lifelong Learning and pro-active attitude in the society and in VET schools).

Description: In the project we intent to develop a training course for VET teachers working with VET students, as a particular target group with more risk of drop-out than in the general education. In this respect, the project focuses on the importance of continuous training for VET teachers that have to face the necessity of reducing the number of the early school leavers during the next years. Reducing early school leaving is essential for achieving a number of key objectives in the Europe 2020 strategy.  
We will develop Quality assurance procedures for reducing drop-outs in VET schools, to be included in the general quality school management. Additionally we will initiate also special quality assurance teams for dealing with and for coordinating the implementation of the quality assurance procedures regarding drop-outs in the project life, as well as after the project ends.

## Produit 'Project Logo'

Titre: Project Logo

Type de Produit: Autres

Texte marketing: By representing the project with a unique, distinctive and self-explanatory logo, which, given that FEIGHT's ultimate beneficiary target audience is young school-age people, is appropriately based on 'text-speak' (F + eight = FEIGHT).

Description: The logo's design solves the problem of how to design a logo for a project with the complex abstract title 'The 8 solutions for fighting early school leaving in VET'. By separating the two verbal elements of the FEIGHT acronym, which are the letter 'F' and the written number 'eight', we get F + eight = FEIGHT. We replace the written 'eight' with the number 8 to get F8, which is pronounced 'Feight'. F8 then becomes the main element of the logo. We sit it on top of the FEIGHT acronym so that it is 100% clear how the F8 should be interpreted and spoken. Finally, using the same blended 4 colours throughout, we spell out the full title of the project, which can either sit directly below, and to the same measure (width), as the rest of the logo, or be enlarged to form a fly-out to the right of the main logo.

Except Module 2 (which was produced by IVN only in November 2014, with more than one month after the project ended), ADASTRA edited all the final products in English.

Description: The result was created by Quarter Mediation, Adastra, Shalom, DIMEM and NIMEM. It shows how to use the following teaching and training methods based on the eight multiple intelligences:

- M1. working with real assignments;
  - M2. using outdoor activities and training in the nature;
  - M3. extracurricular activities;
  - M4. peer training;
  - M5. e-learning;
  - M6. using music, art, play, drama as teaching methods;
  - M7. soft skills (team building, team working, communication);
  - M8. Learning by doing in VET, in a real life situation
- It also give feedback from the learners involved in the pilot activities.

## Produit 'Quality procedures for reducing drop-outs in VET schools'

Titre: Quality procedures for reducing drop-outs in VET schools

Type de Produit: Procédure pour l'analyse et le pronostic des besoins de la formation professionnelle

Texte marketing: The quality procedures were designed and created, based on the experience of QMED which created the draft forms and the first quality procedures tested later on in the participants schools from Italy and Turkey (directly involved in the consortium or working in partnership with one of the partners in the consortium).

Description: The procedures were created by Quarter Mediation, Shalom, DIMEM and NIMEM and there were applied in Turkish and Italian schools as written below:  
-the 2 quality procedures created by QMED were piloted and tested in all Turkish and Italian schools involved in the project;  
-SHALOM, DIMEM and NIMEM created each of them 2 quality procedures and piloted and tested one of the 2 procedures they produced and one or the procedures produced by one of the other partners (eg. Shalom tested one of its procedure and one produced by a Turkish organisation);  
- IVN created the 2 procedures only in November 2014 and it provided the project partners with the relevant documents together with the procedures, also in November 2014 (so it was not possible to use also these testing results in the final outcomes, for example in the app). The process was coordinated (in each school): by a special team created for this purpose (including school teachers, representatives of parents association and school manager) / by the school manager

## Produit 'Collection of innovative teaching and training approaches and methods for reducing early school leaving in VET'

Titre: Collection of innovative teaching and training approaches and methods for reducing early school leaving in VET

Type de Produit: Matériel d'apprentissage

Texte marketing: QMED, IVN, SHALOM, DIMEM and NIMEM had to contribute with at least 3 good practice examples from any of the teaching and training methods allocated per partner, but the project team was very enthusiastic, so the partners in the consortium created more good practice examples as listed below:

- QMED: 5 examples
- SHALOM: 6 examples
- DIMEM: 4 examples
- NIMEM: 4 examples
- ADASTRA: 2 examples (even it was not compulsory for this organization).

Therefore, even IVN didn't provide the examples in the project life, the total number of good practice examples (15) was not only fulfilled, but also exceeded (the consortium produced 21 examples in the project life).

Description: The project partners QMED, ADASTRA, DIMEM, SHALOM and NIMEM created 21 good practice example (even the minimum number to be created in the project was 8, the project team was very enthusiastic and created more methods).

Both the partners and the teachers spoke about a better motivation of students, social effects (team work, cohesion), the positive effects of real life experiences, and the positive effects on the individual students (including instructive effects and personal development) due to the FEIGHT methods. The methods seem to have had the most effect on team work and on self-confidence of students. Partners seem to be somewhat more optimistic about this than the teachers. They additionally indicated that the FEIGHT project was also instructive for themselves (see also external evaluation report at <http://www.ldvfeight.eu/>).

Titre: Guidelines app for teachers working with VET students in risk of drop-out

Type de Produit: Autres

Texte marketing: The Guidelines App is for teachers working with children at risk of early school-leaving and other related problems and provides them with a simple, portable, easy-to-access set of resources: procedures, questionnaires and examples. These resources are available mainly in English, Turkish and Italian, plus some Dutch versions, through a simple web-based product, which can equally be used on a smartphone (IOS, Android or Windows Phone), tablet, laptop or classroom whiteboard. The product is downloadable for these different platforms via the project website. It also contains links to the FEIGHT and Lifelong Learning websites and information about the project partners.

Description: The Guidelines app was produced by Aداstra Cymru (P3) and Quarter Mediation (P2), as being one of main tangible outcomes of the project and contributed as planned to the project objectives. Originally it was proposed to make the app only in English on the project website, and each partner was free to translate it in its mother tongue (if necessary) after adapting it to the national system of education and to the regional/local situation; however, the output was published on the project website also in Turkish and Italian; some of the documents were translated also in Dutch. The part of IVN was not included in the app because it was not provided in the project life. Even so, the app contains a good representative selection of content.

## Produit 'Training package for peer training for teachers and trainers'

Titre: Training package for peer training for teachers and trainers

Texte marketing: As part of the transfer of innovation from Wales to the other FEIGHT partner countries, the training package was adapted from handbooks developed for the previous PEPE TOI project, with permission from that project's lead partner, Gower College Swansea. Two handbooks were developed for PEPE. The first was the "Training Trainers Programme", which was designed to increase the quality of training provided to peer education trainers and the training they delivered in their institutions, thus raising the quality of provision and assisting in raising the quality of training for the target groups. The second was the "Peer Education Training Course", an innovative training programme developed through the previous PIP TOI project. Both handbooks were redesigned and repurposed for FEIGHT and consist respectively of 68 and 198 pages.

Description: The handbooks were part of the main tangible outcomes of the project and contributed as planned to the project objectives.  
The Peer Education training method aimed to increase the personal communication and relationship skills both of peer educators and the target groups of disadvantaged people in education and the workplace. It aimed to increase the social and employability skills of the target groups through personal development exercises delivered by trained peer educators.
