Summary of Dissemination Workshop: Meeting Outcomes

CARDET held the second dissemination workshop related to the Digital Latin Quarter (DLQ) project on November 22, 2013. The workshop was attended by relevant stakeholders, including educators, academics, representatives of the Ministry of Education and Culture and the Pedagogical Institute of Cyprus, associates of second-chance education opportunities, relevant NGO representatives, and youth worker representatives.

After a welcome note by CARDET's Director, Dr. Charalambos Vrasidas, all the participants were invited to introduce themselves and the organisations/services that they represented. A standard presentation regarding the DLQ project followed, presenting a brief summary of the project as well as the main aims and objectives that were set with the initiation of the project. The main outcomes, key tools, and resources of the project were presented and the participants had the chance to watch parts of the work completed by the film crews composed by young people in each of the four participating countries with a special focus on Cyprus. Furthermore, the workshop facilitators presented a short version of the presentation created and presented by Declan Cassidy of Timesnap at the final conference of the DLQ project that took place in October 2013 in Cyprus. This presentation offered the participants with a practical approach to integrating film and digital media in the classroom. The participants discussed DLQ's potential in the Cypriot context, as well as its short-term and long-term

applications in their fields. There was an overall positive approach to the project's outcomes and final products.

Comments/Feedback:

The presentations were followed by a series of questions raised by the workshop participants on issues pertaining to the way that the trainings with youth-at-risk and youth workers were conducted, as well as the impact of the trainings on the persons that completed them.

After the completion of the question and answer session, tea/coffee and snacks were offered and participants had the chance to socialise and discuss further on the project. In general, the participants seemed to enjoy the atmosphere that was created at the workshop and they exhibited a collective sense of acknowledgment and support for the importance of the work completed by the project partners, the youth-at-risk, and the youth workers that participated in the project.

The event ended with CARDET's representatives thanking everyone for their participation and time.
